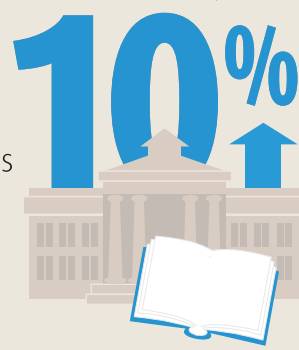

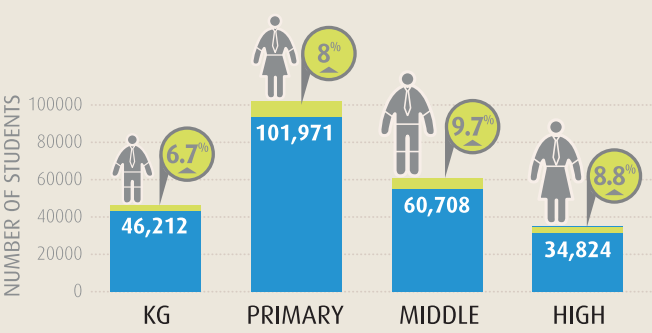


Education on the rise: More schools, more universities, more students

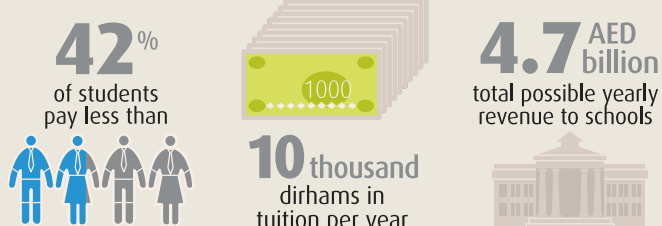
Dubai's private schools and higher education sectors have grown steadily in capacity and enrolment since 2007.

23k Seats added to meet increasing demand



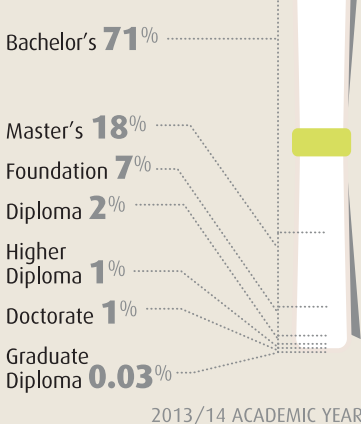
Fees range from AED 1,725 to AED 98,000 per year

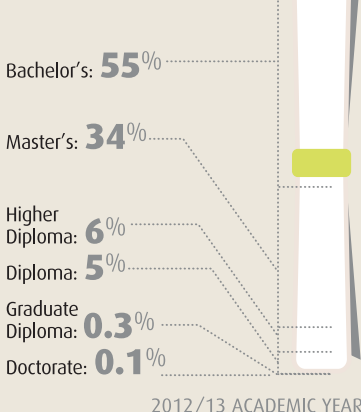

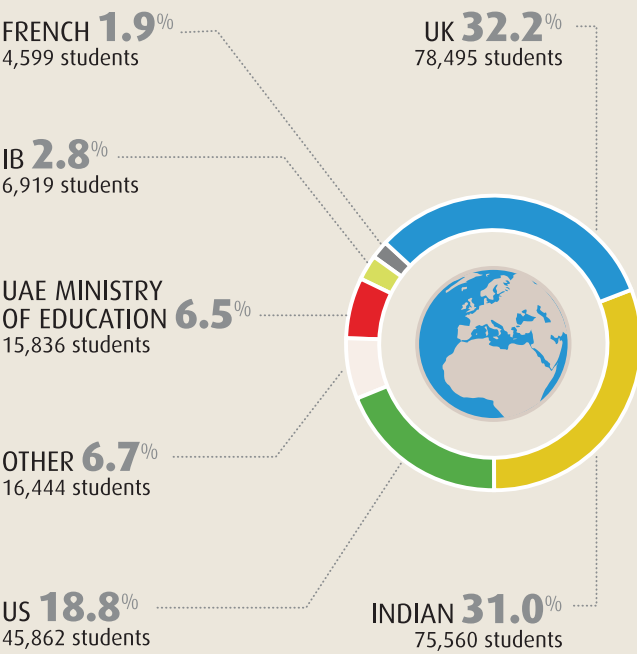

An increasing number of private schools and higher education institutions offer a range of curricula and programmes to support a growing student population.

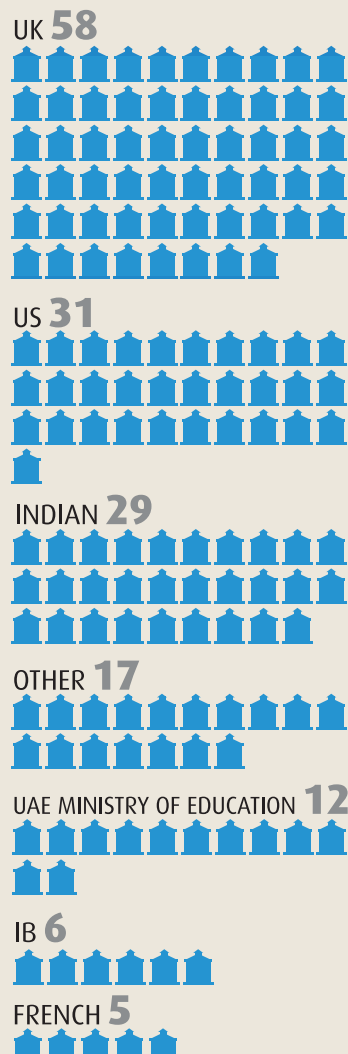

Percentage of enrolment by curriculum type:

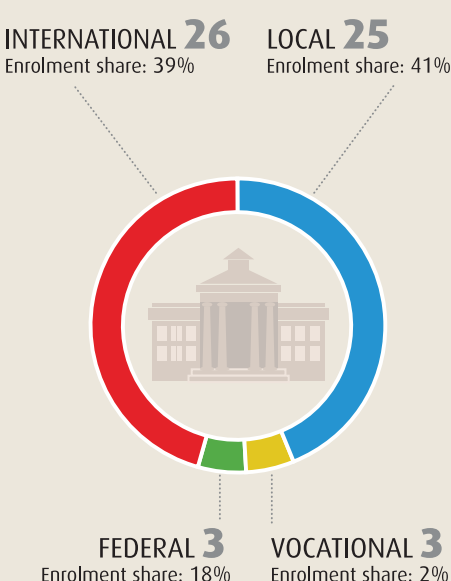


Number of schools by curriculum type:



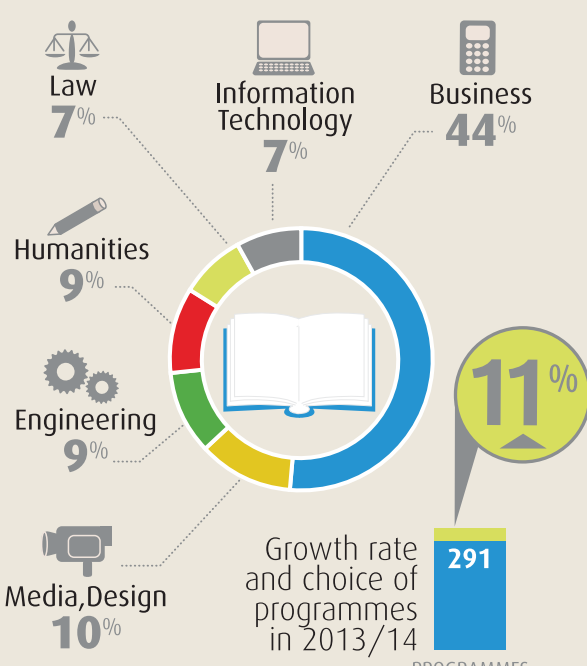

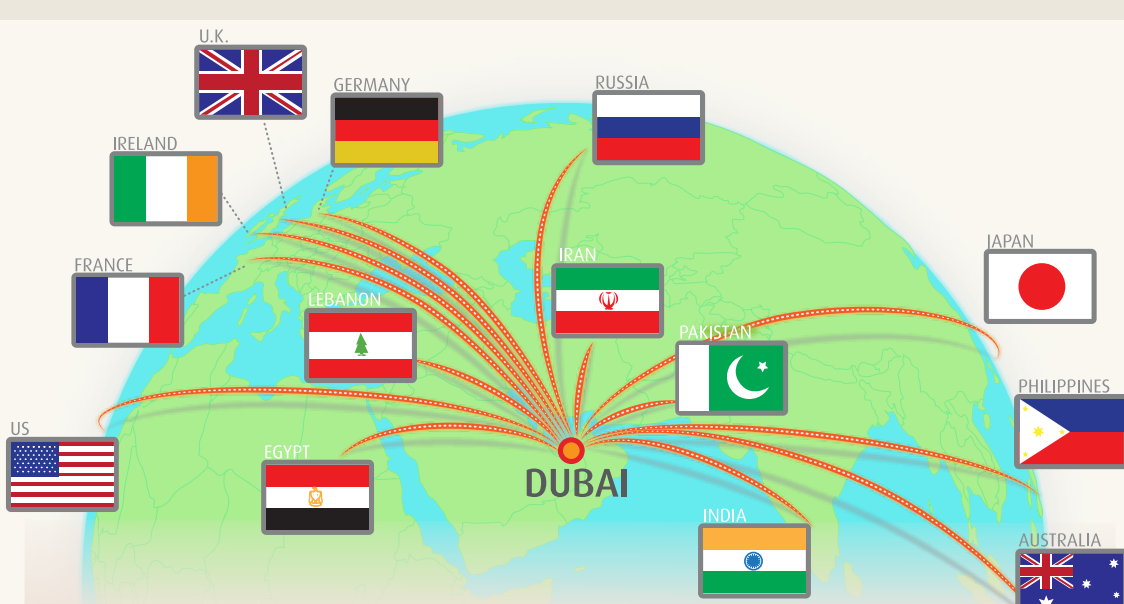
