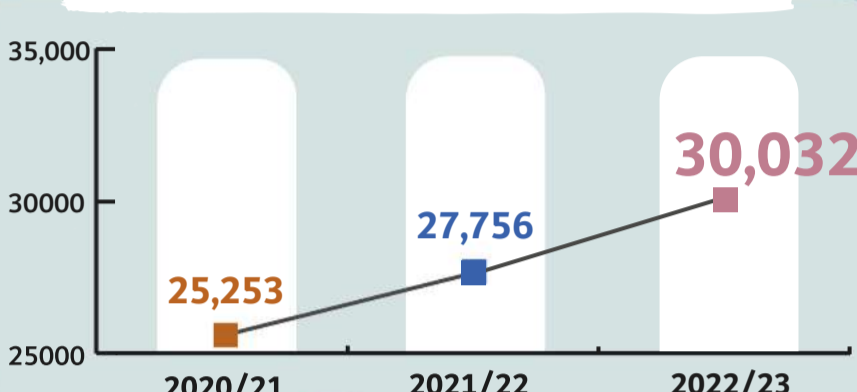

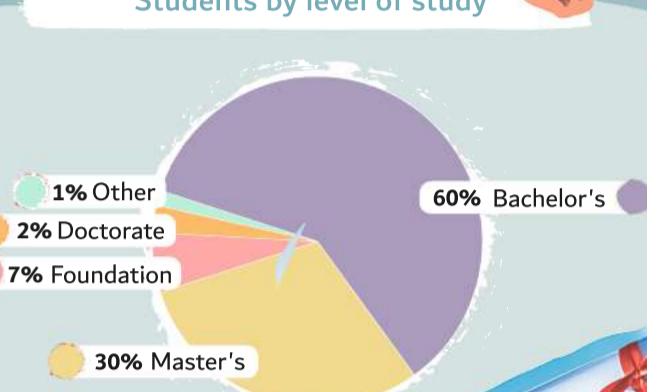

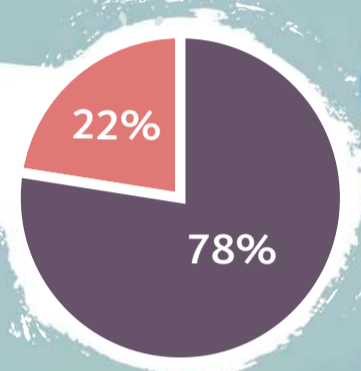
Number of students (3-year trend)



Students by level of study



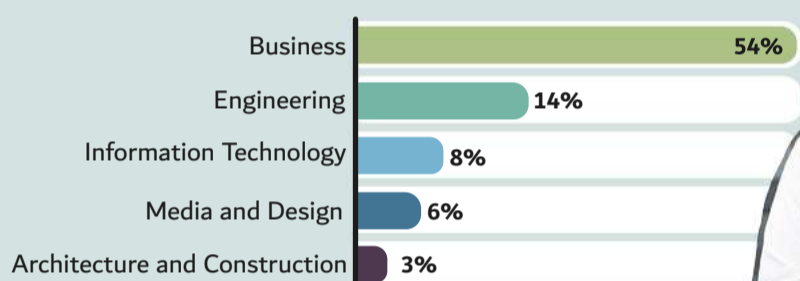
Students enrolled full-time and part-time

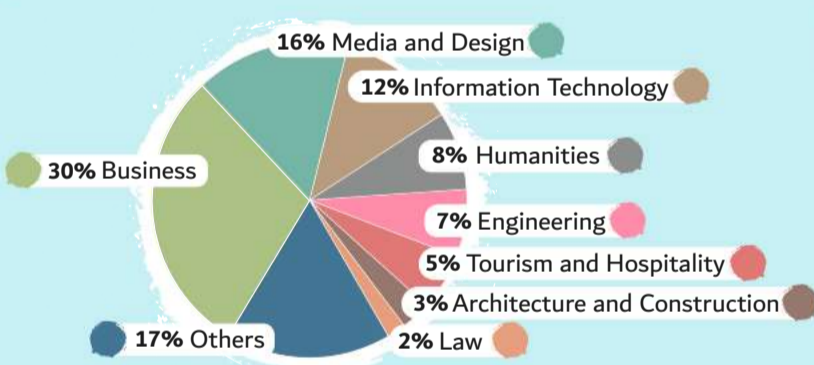

69% of these graduates are in the UAE.

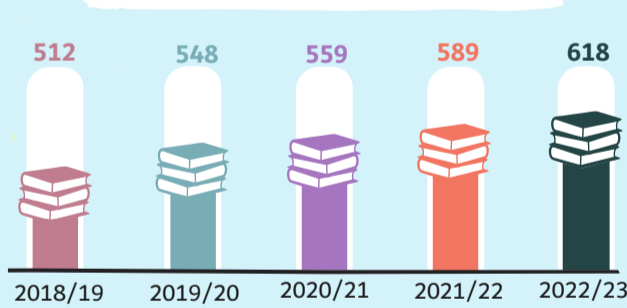

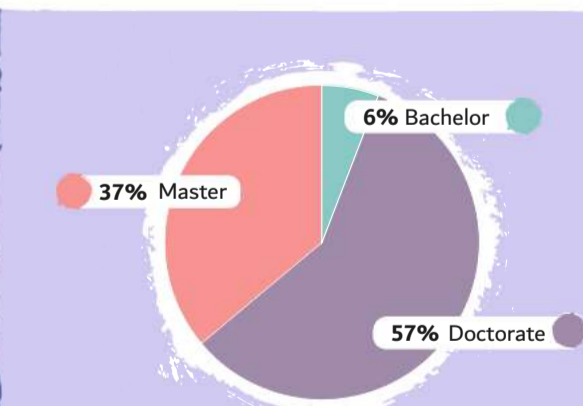
Number of programmes (5-year trend)



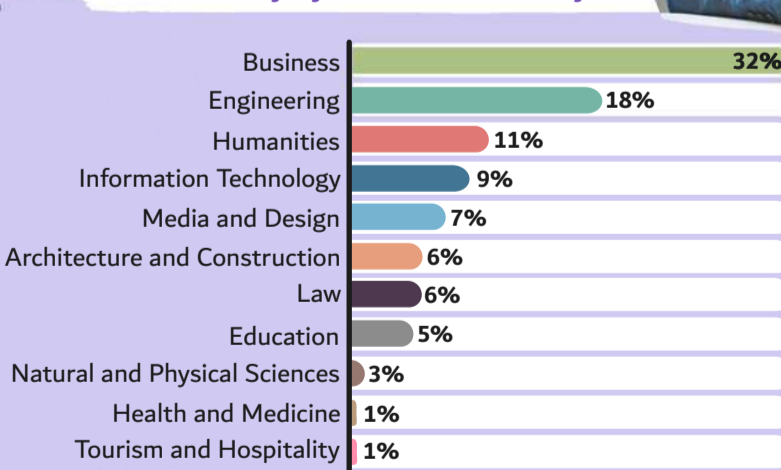

Faculty by qualifications

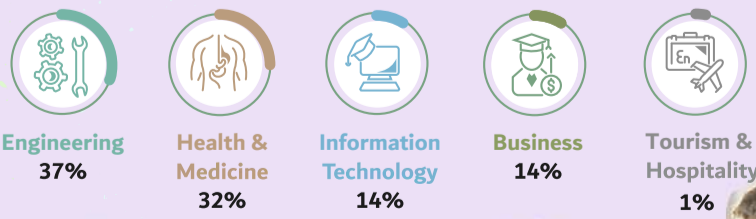


Faculty by main field of study

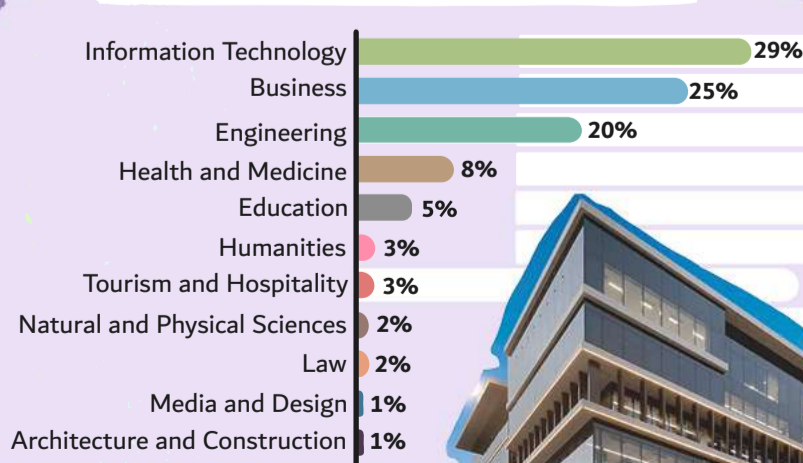
